

RYA Intermediate Powerboat Course

This course covers the practical use of pilotage and passage planning by day on coastal waters using both traditional and electronic navigational techniques.

During the two days you also cover more advanced boat handling. It is recommended for anyone considering moving on to the Advanced course.

Assumed knowledge	Boat handling to the standard of the Level 2 course with a coastal endorsement. Knowledge to the level of Day Skipper theory is recommended. It is strongly recommended that candidates hold a first aid certificate and a VHF/SRC operators certificate.
Minimum duration	2 days
Minimum age	16
Course content	Planning a day cruise, boat preparation, boat handling, pilotage, passage making, man overboard
Ability after the course	Able to plan and execute short coastal passages by day
